Dear Registrant/Licensee:

Please find attached the following Notices with respect to:

- the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Afghanistan) (Order), 2018 – (S.I. No. 56 of 2018) ("the Afghanistan Order") which was circulated to registrants/licensees on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019;
- the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Iraq) Order, 2018 – (S.I. No. 57 of 2018) ("the Iraq Order") which was circulated to registrants/licensees on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019;
- (iii) the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Democratic People's Republic of Korea) (Order), 2019 – (S.I. No. 23 of 2019) ('the DPRK Order") which was circulated to registrants/licensees on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2019; and
- (iv) the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Iran) (Order), 2019 – (S.I. No. 36 of 2019) ('the Iran Order") which was circulated to registrants/licensees on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019.

Pursuant to the Orders all registrants/licensees were required to review their databases and records (including transaction records) **and notify the Commission as well as the Financial Intelligence Unit regarding the Afghanistan Order and the Iraq Order by 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2019; the DPRK Order by 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019; the Iran Order by 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2019 of any findings related to persons or entities named in the specified Orders.** 

The original deadlines established to submit the results of your review have now passed. To confirm compliance, with the Orders and Sanctions list the Commission hereby requires that ALL registrants/licensees, who have not already done so, submit a report of their findings to the Commission within forty eight hours of the date of this Notice and in any event no later than close of business on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2019. *(See: Form 1A attached)* 

The Commission hereby clarifies and requires that where the review of your transactions and databases yield NO positive results, registrants/licensees MUST submit a NIL report to the Commission. *(See: Form 1B attached)* 

In addition, the Commission advises that registrants/licensees are required to review all transactions, records and databases against any Orders issued under the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Act and the United Nations Securities Council Sanctions List on a quarterly basis and provide the Commission with the required reports and confirmations. Quarterly reports should be made by the submission of Form 1A or Form 1B, as appropriate.

Please be advised that failure to submit the required reports may result in disciplinary action, including a minimum fine of \$200.00 per day per Order.

Further, please be reminded that Registrants and Licensees are also required to file an annual declaration, certifying that their operations are in full compliance with the provisions of the aforementioned Orders, signed by at least two (2) Directors of its Board of Directors or in the alternative, one (1) Director and the compliance officer registered with the Commission. Further the Commission hereby advises that the filing deadline relative to annual declaration is 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019. *(See: Form 2 attached)*
