## Re: International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Act, Chapter 16 ("IOEAMA")

Pursuant to powers conferred by section 3 of the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Act, Chapter 16 ("IOEAMA"), licensees and registrants of the Securities Commission of The Bahamas ("the Commission") are hereby informed that the Governor General of The Commonwealth of The Bahamas has issued the following order:

1. International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Iran) Order, 2019 – (S.I. No. 36 of 2019) ("the Iran Order").

Licensees and registrants are advised, that pursuant to Part IV of the Anti-Terrorism Act, 2018 (ATA), the circulation of the above-mentioned order is to aid in ensuring full compliance by financial institutions with the obligations emanating therefrom.

Licensees and registrants are urged to take all appropriate actions to ensure full compliance with the Iran Order, Part IV, "Implementation of United Nations Security Resolutions", of the ATA, and section 8 of the Anti-Terrorism Regulations, 2019 – (S.I. No. 9 of 2019) (ATR). Confirmation of compliance with the relevant provisions by licensees and registrants must be furnished to the Commission within 30 days of the issuance of this notice. Please note that licensees and registrants are also required to submit confirmations of compliance and declarations to the Commission where there are no findings or 'hits'.

Licensees and registrants are also required to file an annual declaration, certifying that their operations are in full compliance with the provisions of the Iran Order, signed by at least 2 directors of its Board of Directors or in the alternative, its compliance officers.
